Annelida Lucette Richardson was born on February 23, 1958. She was the second child born to the union of Allen Louis Richardson and Bennie Joyce Wright Richardson. She was baptized at Phillips Temple in 1958. And continued to work in the church through her young adult life. Annelida was educated in Berkeley public schools - Malcolm X (Lincoln) Elementary, Willard Junior and Berkeley High from which she graduated in 1976. She then attended Howard University majoring in communications.

Annelida retired from federal service in 2012 having work for social security 35 yrs. She worked her way up the ladder from Clerk to the upper level management/administrative level. Along the way she was a shop steward, service and claims representative, supervisor, Berkley District office manager and finally retiring as San Rafael Office manager. During her career as a federal employee Annelida received numerous awards for outstanding performance, including the Commissioner's Citation, traveling to Washington, DC to accept it. She participated in the Junior Management Assistant Program.

Annelida was aware of the struggles she encountered in moving up the ladder and reached back to mentor other young black women in developing their professional careers.

Annelida was a sweet soul who loved her family. She could always be counted on to support her family in any way needed. The family describes her as: Loving, kind, big-hearted, generous, fun, inspiring, adventurous, independent. Music, bowling, shopping, photography and travel were favorite pastimes throughout her life.

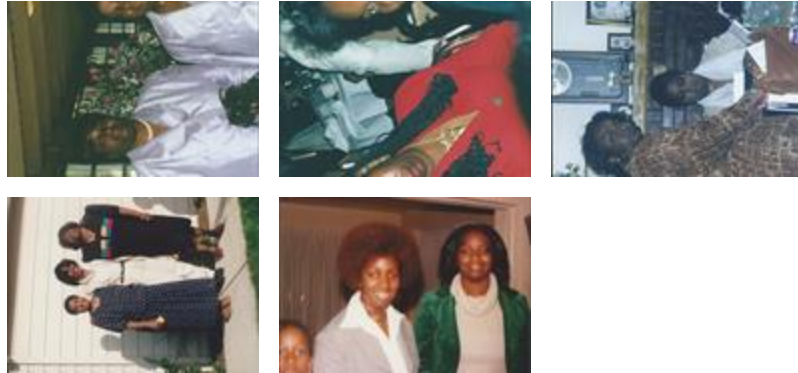
