Arthur Polk, a Local Icon and Music Afficionado, passed away on November 20, 2014 at the age of 85. He was distinctively and affectionately known as "Art" to his family and multitude of friends throughout the world.

Art was born on October 20, 1929 in Kerens, Texas. As a young boy, he and his family migrated to California and settled in West Oakland. It was there that he discovered and immersed himself into the world of music and especially the phenomenal world of Bebop.

Art joined the US Navy at age 17, went out to see the world and continued a deeper exploration of the Bebop artform. Bebop would eventually become his life.

In the 1970s, he was one of the founding members of the Berkeley Flea Market.

Here he spread his knowledge of Bebop and Jazz through his merchandising of collectable vinyl, CDs, art and memorabilia. As a result of touching so many of the international visitors to the market, he established a worldwide reputation as a Bebop Expert and Music Afficionado .

Art died after a long battle with a lung condition.
