Curtis “Jack” Thomas was born on June 6, 1921, in Gibsland, Louisiana to Louis and Inez Thomas. He attended the public school system in Gibsland. He enlisted into the army when he graduated from high school at 17 years of age. He was in the army for two years. He received an honorable discharge as a private first class. He returned home to Gibsland for a short time and when his father moved to California he soon followed and settled in Alameda, California. He was employed for a time at Oakland Airport and after he dislocated his disc on the job, he went to trade school and became a heavy machine operator. He worked for American Canning Company for the next 30 years and retired.

He met and married Elnora in the early 40s. From that union no children were born. He settled in Oakland after his marriage. He was later divorced and never remarried.

Curtis accepted Christ at an early age and was baptized. He was very quiet, easy going, low key and loved his family.

His parents, Louis and Inez Thomas; sister, Pauline Harmon and brother, Henry Thomas, preceded him in death.
