Daniel became an employee at Naval Air Station, Alameda, California in 1967, he became the First African American Supervisor at the Naval base. After 38 years of service, he retired. Daniel served in the ARMY and was honorable discharge.

Daniel join the Masonic – Acacia Lodge #7 on November 18, 1963. He was elected Worshipful Master in 1976 and served the Most Worshipful Prince Hall Grand Lodge, Free and Accepted Masons of California, Incorporated on Civic Affairs, Jirisprudence and Research & Education committees and in 2013 he was honored by being awarded Life membership for over 52 years of service.
