



Harvey Lee Jackson

September 2, 1958 - October 11, 2015

Harvey Lee Jackson, the 9th of ten siblings was born September 2, 1958 in Camden, Texas, to the parents of Melvin and Johnett Jackson. He was educated in public school in Polk County and graduated from Chester High School, Chester, Texas. After graduation Harvey joined the military and served eight years in the United States Army as a medic.

Harvey later moved to California and joined Ollie Grove Baptist Church under the leadership of Dr. Alvin Baker, Jr. He was a very active and involved member in many aspects of the ministry: ten years of service as a deacon; eleven years of service as a Chairman of Deacon and deaconess; and 20+ years as a Deacon and Minister of Education; 20+ years as Young Adults and Adult Sunday School Teacher. Minister Jackson taught his last class on October 10, 2015 on "The Servant Leader".

Harvey worked full time for 20+ years at the University of California at Berkeley as a Facility Manager Specialist III while attending Sacramento Theological Seminary Bible College and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Christian Education. Being very involved and active in the Ministry, he continued (an additional five years) and earned a Doctoral Degree in Divinity. Pastor Baker shared to all, "A Deacon with a Doctoral Degree in Divinity." However, he remained very humble and the Harvey we all loved. He had a fondness for all young people to attend college and enjoyed spending time with the elders.

Harvey's love for God served others. Pastor Baker ordained him July 2014 and

he delivered his first sermon on Matthew 25:14-30, "What are you afraid of". The following Sunday he was appointed Minister in charge until his Home Going.

On November 2, 2013 God showed him favor by blessing him with his wife, Betty (Bea) Jackson at the revival who helped him to continue God's Plan and Pastor Baker's vision.

Reverend Harvey Jackson was preceded in death by his parents: Melvin and Johnett Jackson; three brothers: James, Charles, Reverend John Jackson; older sister, Hattie Marie Hill.

Reverend Harvey Jackson is survived by his wife, Betty Jackson of El Sobrante California; two sons: Mario Tyler, Emmanuel Tyler; one brother, Irving Jackson; sister-in-law, Rita Jackson of Moscow Texas; four sisters: Carol Jackson of Houston, Texas, Mercy Jackson of Camden, Texas, Wilma and Mable Jackson of Berkeley, California; one sister-in-law, Jacqueline Jackson of Houston, Texas; one brother-in-law, Dave Hill of Lufkin, Texas along with fourteen grandchildren, a great granddaughter and a host of nieces, nephew, aunt, and friends.

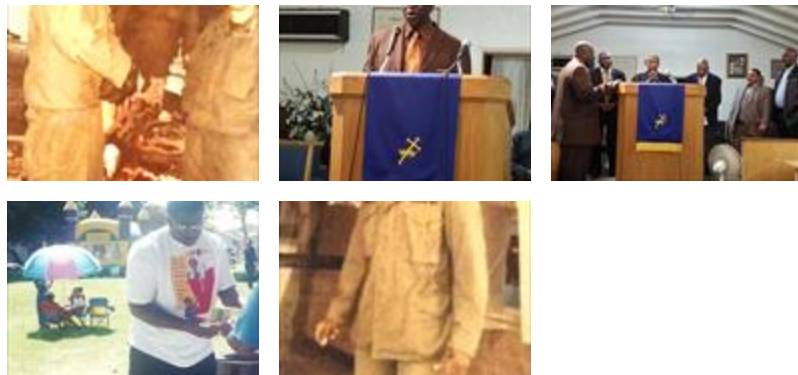
