



## Hattie B Dunn

July 4, 1922 - May 18, 2015

Hattie Dunn was the fourth child born to the union of Lindsey and Lovie Lee Dunn in Holly, Louisiana on July 4, 1922

The family moved to Arkansas where she and her siblings grew up confessed hope in Christ and was baptized. She attended and graduated from Merrill High School in Pine Bluff.

In 1946 she moved to Oakland, California where she worked as a cook and seamstress. Hattie joined Friendship Baptist Church (Joshua Christian Center) in the early 1960's and attended Merritt College in Oakland.

Hattie had a wide circle of friends who found her to be a good listener and a loyal friend. She loved the blues and gospel as well as jazz, especially B.B. King and Miles Davis. She had a great sense of humor, gave sound advice and wasn't afraid to speak her mind.

As the oldest sister and mother, her family came first and she loved her family and was supportive when needed. Green was her favorite color and she loved fast cars (Corvette Stingray), traveling, and people in general.

Hattie departed this life at Alta Bates Hospital, Berkeley, California on May 18, 2015. Her father, Lindsey Dunn, brother's -L.D. Dunn, Robert Dunn, and Charles Dunn, Sr. Sisters - Lovely Lee Dunn-World, Alberta Dunn-Bynum and her mother, Lovie L. Dunn, preceded her in death.

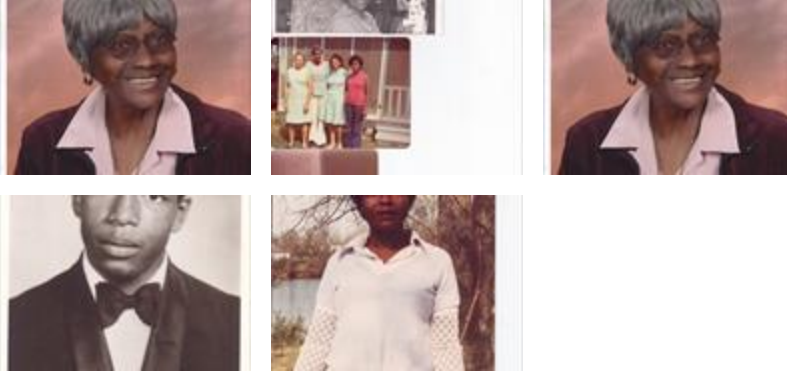
