On the morning of January 27, 2016 at the Redwood Convalescent Hospital James Harris, Jr went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

He is survived by his second wife Bessie (Cain) Harris and his two sons Calvin and Terry (by his first wife Varue Neeley -deceased), four grandsons Calvin Jr, Christopher, Brandon and Austin and sisters Quincie Warfield, Alice Marie Evans and Archie Vee Blakely and numerous nieces and nephews!

James Harris.... better known as Jimmy, Uncle Jimmy, or Mr. Harris and his son's favorites were "Pops" or the "old man" was the first born son of eleven children born to James and Annie Mae Harris 93 years ago in Arkansas.

Growing up on a farm, he learned about working hard to take care of the family. He carried that principal throughout his life.

With only an eighth grade education, he accomplished so much that he probably didn't realize what he had done... from serving in the Army during WWII becoming a sergeant, driving big rig trucks, working at the Ford Motor company for 30 plus years as a maintenance welder to security guard at the Oakland Coliseum.

Mr. Harris was old school on how he provided for his family, he believed you had to work hard to support your family ... he always had a job. He preached

this work ethic to all, especially his sons. He loved working on his cars and doing repairs around the house and having a crisp looking lawn. He wasn't a workaholic; he did sneak in his fishing days!

And when it came to discipline, he also was old school too... whippings were a major part of his disciplinary program (only when deserved), no back talk was allowed, and you got one free get out of jail card!

Because of his illness, he entered into nursing home care in 2003; this is where he spent the last days of his life. There were many nurses and doctors that took care of him over the years and the family is very appreciative for the care they provided.
