



Jimmie Cry

July 24, 1927 - January 5, 2012

Jimmie Cry, III was born July 24, 1927 to the proud parents Sarah Cry and Reverend Jimmie Cry of New Orleans, Louisiana; both preceded him in death. Jimmie departed this life January 5, 2012. Also preceded him in death sisters, Minnie Lee Hardy of Oakland, California, Beatrice Hall of Vicksburg, Mississippi, and Martha Norford of Long Beach, California.

Jimmie served in the United States Army before attending San Francisco State University. He was employed by the California Department of Corrections and was first hired as a Correctional Officer at San Quentin State Prison. In the 1960's, Jimmie was later promoted to Correctional Sergeant and was the first African-American assigned to work inside the prison's housing units. He was later promoted to Parole Agent in San Francisco and finally to Supervisory Parole Agent II, in Oakland California. Jimmie retired from the Department of Corrections after 25 years.
