



## Jimmie Lee Dalton

May 8, 1922 - January 21, 2014

Jimmie Lee Dalton was born May 8, 1922 in Yazoo County, Mississippi to the late Tilmon and Lucille (Weathers) Armfield. She was the youngest of three siblings. After the death of their mother, they were reared by their grandparents, the late Perry (Hunt) and Lizzie Weathers.

As a child Jimmie united with New Foundation Baptist Church where she confessed her faith and hope in Jesus Christ, and that she would faithfully serve Him all of her life. Jimmie was educated in the Yazoo County Public School System.

Friends and family knew they would have a good visit when they entered her home. She also loved sewing and was always enrolled in classes to learn new or improved techniques. Jimmie was active with the Berkeley Senior Center and the Richmond Senior Center where she attended a Journalism class and sewing classes until she was unable to attend due to her health.

Jimmie found the church that she loved, and united with Ollie Grove Baptist Church under the pastorate of Rev. Elvin Baker. She loved working with the children and found great pleasure in teaching Sunday school. Often times she spoke of the children how they grew into wonderful adults and how proud she was when she saw them or heard from them. She also enjoyed serving as Deaconess on the Mother' s Board served until her health no longer permitted her to do so. She spoke endlessly and lovingly of her church family and how much she loved them and how she enjoyed their visits and fellowship.

Jimmie departed this life January 21, 2014 at 10:56 at Kaiser Hospital, at Oakland, California, after a short hospitalization, to be with the Lord.

Jimmie Lee's older sisters Leanner Silkett and Lurenzia W. Cobbs preceded her in death.
