



## Lola Mae Walker

May 7, 1924 - January 2, 2015

Mrs. Lola Mae Cook Waller, the oldest child of Mr. Howard and Mrs. Vernita Ellis Cook was born May 7, 1924 in Powell “Elm Flat Community”, Texas.

Her formal education began at the age of six in the Powell ISD and continued thru graduation in 1941 at G. W. Jackson High School, Corsicana, Texas.

Lola was reared and grew up in a loving family where the Bible was read, discipline was taught and obedience was a demand. She confessed a hope in Christ at an early age in the Woods Chapel A.M.E. Church. After the family moved to Corsicana, Texas, she united with Bethel A.M.E. Church. There she served as musician for several years.

“Lola”, as she was affectionally called by her family, married her high school sweetheart, Leon C. Waller. For a short time, they lived in Durham, North Carolina during World War II. In 1944, they moved to California and made it their home state.

She continued her Christian belief and united with Liberty Hill Baptist Church, Berkeley, California under the leadership of Rev. Lewis. There she served as musician for 40+ years. Her life was a summary of six numbers: family, children, church, music, motherhood and singing.

“Lola” departed this life, Friday, January 2, 2015 in San Lorenzo, California with her children at her bedside. Her husband, parents, daughter Locephus, son Dwight, and brother Harlee Cook preceded her in death.
