



## Rosa Collier McCann

June 23, 1918 - August 9, 2012

ROSA McCANN was born on June 23, 1918, in St. Francisville, Louisiana to the union of Joseph and Mary Williams. Rosa was one of eleven children.

Rosa Williams moved to New Orleans, Louisiana at an early age and later attended Xavier University. During World War II she moved to Washington D.C. to work for the Department of Defense.

In August of 1945 Rosa came to California to marry Earl McCann and her life as a devoted wife and mother began.

While her husband served in and retired from the United States Navy, Rosa was a devoted Navy wife. She was an active member of the Fleet Reserve Association, the Unit K-West & B-East, Inc., and the Nineteen Plus, Inc. Rosa strongly believed in education and, while raising three children, she took special pride in working as a Teacher's Aide for the Berkeley Unified School District.

Rosa entrusted God in every aspect of her life, and was a faithful and dedicated member of the First African Methodist Episcopal Church in Oakland, California, where she served as a member of the Missionary Society.
