Remembering the life of Rosie Leetta Harris.....

Mrs. Rosie Leetta Harris, the fifth child of 10 children born to the late Wyatt Brock, Sr, and Sally (Starr) Brock Muldrow, Oklahoma, grew up attending Shady Grove Baptist Church, Rosemwald Elementary School, and Vian High School. She departed this life on December 13, 2015 at a local hospital.

In her early life she met and was united in Holy Matrimony to Mr. Frank James Harris and to this union one daughter was born. She moved to California as a young adult and later worked in the Food Services Department of the University of California in Berkeley for 14 years before leaving it to enjoy gardening and traveling. She traveled to New York, Washington D.C., Hawaii, down south, as well as to Europe; England, France, Germany and Holland. She was a faithful member of Liberty Hill Baptist Church for many years under the pastoral direction of Reverend W.C. Ellis and later under Reverend M. Peoples until she became unable to attend. She also was a member of the Order of Eastern Star, South Gate Chapter No.27 where she was active for many years and served as Worthy Matron in 1977 and 1978 and also a member of the American Legion Auxiliary Post 695.

She was totally devoted to the organizations she served but was even more devoted to her family. She loved preparing large elaborate meals for family, friends and neighbors for every holiday or "just because". She would plan six dishes and always end up with at least twice that amount. She could do it quickly but it always tasted good. Everyone was welcome and all were asked

to take some food home.

She was a basketball fan. She loved watching the games on t.V, long before the Warriors started winning she was a devout fan or theirs. She referred to them as “her boys”
