Hence forth there is laid up for me a crown of righteousness which the Lord the righteous judge shall give me Rosie Washington was the 4th child of 14 born to Oscar and Theresa Flippin on June 30th 1925. She confessed her faith in Christ at an early age and was baptized in Shreveport Louisiana by the late Rev.J.D. Thomas, at the Friendship Baptist Church.

By Rosie being one of the older children she was given the responsibility of taking care of her younger siblings. She attended the local public schools in Shreveport Louisiana and after school she was often found helping her parents around the house with cooking and household chores. Rosie was a natural care giver.

She met and married L.B Washington, and in 1945 her husband, herself and her 3 small children moved from Shreveport Louisiana to Oakland, CA in search of a better life. L.B. found work at the Oakland Naval Supply and was the sole bread winner, while Rosie was a stay at home mom until her children were school age. She then began working as a Housekeeper in the Oakland, Berkeley area for many years.

Rosie was sweet as pie, you could ask anybody that ever had the opportunity

to meet her, and she would divide her very last with you. And in the time of need Rosie would put on that Apron, Roll up them sleeves and get to work when ever and where ever she was needed, but she didn't stop there, she wouldn't leave until her Job was done, and your belly was full.

She was a faithful member at Liberty Hill Baptist Church for over 40 years, she also was apart of the Mission Ministry and was often called upon to lead Alter Prayer. In later years because of her mobility she was unable to attend regular services, but she still remained a faithful and upstanding member.
