- Sandra Robertson Owens was born June 23 1946, in Oakland to the parents of Virginia Evelyn Robertson and Kenneth P. Robertson who preceded her in death. She was the only child. Sandra is the granddaughter of Dr. Herman and Ethol Lewis who also preceded her in death. Her grandfather was the first black dentist in Oakland. Sandra married Larry Stoglines in 1968 and gave birth to twins who preceded her in death.
- Sandra was baptized in 1948 at Saint Mary Catholic Church, she attended Saint Joseph Catholic Church and later joined Saint Ambrose Catholic Church. She was a devoted member until she became ill.
- Sandra attended Franklin Berkeley Elementary School, Burbank Jr. High School and graduated from Berkeley high School in 1963. She furthered her education at Merritt College, San Francisco State University and received a Bachelor of Arts Degree at Cal State Hayward.
- Sandra worked for the Alameda County Probation Department for 33 years. She retired in October of 2005 as a group Counselor Institutional Supervisor. During her retirement she worked part time for the Seniors Helpers. During her earlier years she taught school in Seattle Washington and worked for the Parks and Recreation Department in Oakland.
- Sandra kept her mothers legacy alive. Throughout her life she became involved in the following groups, Links Debutante, Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Today's Women CACAO Branch of Children's Hospital and Patriots of Arts and Humanities. Sandra also enjoyed playing Bid Whist Pinochle but her

passion was bowling. Sandra participated in various bowling leagues and traveled to compete against other leagues. Not only was she active in various groups she was also an avid donor to many non profit organizations.
